Clemens Rohde of Fraunhofer ISI presented the main findings of the project. The Modelling and policy part followed in the latter part of the workshop.

- Entranze Data Mapper
- Behaviour and nZEB acceptance

## Policies for an energy efficient building stock

**Veit Bürger (Öko Institut) (30 min)**

Mr. Veit Bürger presented the Entranze approach on innovative policy instruments to support energetic retrofit aiming at NZEB standard.

Based on this, the German policy sets were presented to introduce the scenario calculations.

**Jan Steinbach (Fraunhofer ISI) (40 min)**

Jan Steinbach presented the INVERT model with a focus on the simulation of investment by agents, which is the main value added of the tool compared to the models presently used and in particular the different inputs data useful for the Entranze forecasts:

- Investment choice
- Typology of stakeholders and corresponding behavioral criteria
- Policy set translation in INVERT
- Exogenous framework condition (energy prices)
- Cost optimal calculation

Afterwards he presented the scenario results for Germany. The results were discussed intensively.

## Discussion

The impacts of the different policy sets was discussed intensively focusing on the embedding of the policy sets in the current political framework.
